



School Uniform Policy

In line with Circular 32/2017, efforts have been made to reduce the cost of the school uniform.

As such, our uniform consists of:

- A crested school tracksuit top (available through the school only via O'Neill's)
 - A white polo shirt (long or short sleeved)
 - Plain navy tracksuit trousers
 - Suitable runners/trainers.
- ✚ Please note that navy leggings/cycle shorts are not acceptable.
 - ✚ Branded tracksuits are also not permitted in school.
 - ✚ Tracksuits must be plain navy only and are widely available in many shops.
 - ✚ In the summer months (during warm weather) plain, navy tracksuit-style shorts are permissible. These must be of an appropriate length.
 - ✚ Please also note that all long hair must be tied back
 - ✚ Long nails/acrylic nails are not permitted in school.
 - ✚ Children are not permitted to wear makeup or fake tan to school. If children come to school with makeup and/or fake tan they will be given makeup remover wipes and asked to remove the makeup. Failure to comply with this request will result in their parent(s) being contacted in relation to a breach of the school's Code of Behaviour.
 - ✚ Your child's school bag is also part of school uniform and it should be kept clean and tidy at all times.
 - ✚ Children should always have a pack of tissues in their school bag
 - ✚ All uniform clothes and jackets must be marked with child's name. The school is not responsible for lost items.
 - ✚ The only items of jewellery allowed are watches and small stud earrings.
